RE: FIFO Boilermaker – Shutdown

Dear Hiring Manager,

I am writing to apply for the FIFO Boilermaker position. With 14+ years of structural and pressure-pipe welding across Pilbara mining shutdowns and major fabrication projects, I bring trade discipline, repeat-engagement reliability, and a 100% NDT pass rate over the last four years.

In my current shutdown engagements with a Pilbara mining services contractor, I have performed structural and pressure-pipe welding across four iron ore shutdowns ranging 14-28 days. I specialise in transfer station chute liner work – measuring, fitting and welding Bisalloy 400/500 abrasion-resistant plate – and have maintained a 100% NDT pass rate across approximately 1,200 inspected welds with no rework calls.

I hold both AS/NZS 1554.1 SP structural and ASME IX high-pressure pipe welder qualifications, which has allowed flexible deployment across structural and piping scopes within the same shutdown. I read isometric and shop drawings independently and have been informal trade leader on two of my recent shutdowns, coordinating chute liner critical-path work for a crew of four.

I hold Working at Heights, Confined Space, Basic Rigging, Dogging, EWP, Forklift, Standard 11, and Senior First Aid – all current. I am available for immediate mobilisation and comfortable on either day or night shift.

I would welcome the opportunity to discuss how my weld qualifications, shutdown reliability, and quality record can contribute to your next campaign.
